INFORMATION FOR TRIALLERS

JUGIONG AREA/SERVICES

Jugiong (population 150) is in southern NSW, situated on the Murrumbidgee River. It is 530 km from Melbourne; 120 km from Canberra; 340 km from Sydney. The town of Gundagai is 40 km away, and has a full range of accommodation and services as has Cootamundra (43 km) and Yass (57 km). Coolac (20 km) has a hotel/motel, but we were advised that booking accommodation there is contingent on major roadworks being brought forward to about that time.

Jugiong has a General Store, 2 Service Stations (one with take-away), a Pub (no accommodation) and a Motel/Bar/Restaurant. The neighbouring towns mentioned above have laundrettes, Vets, Supermarkets, etc.

DRAW DINNERS

Meet the Judges and the draw for the order of running will be held in the Jugiong Hall on Friday, 2nd September at 6.30 pm for the State Championship and on Thursday, 8th September for the National Championship at 6.30 pm.

TROPHY PRESENTATIONS

These will be held for both the State and National in the Jugiong Hall as soon as practicable after the completion of the Championship.

CATERING AT THE TRIAL SITE

As local community groups will be assisting with this, we would hope that you would patronise them; quite a range of food and drink will be available for sale.

NON-COMPETING DOGS

Dogs not entered in the Championships must be submitted for vetting. No dogs at all will be permitted in the gallery area at any time.

SPECTATORS

Specific gallery areas will be designated for the viewing of the runs. We would ask that all spectators maintain quiet in the gallery area during the runs and, unless invited by the Judge, will not be permitted in the vicinity of the control area.

MEMORABILIA FOR SALE

We have a range of items for sale at the Championships – Polo t-shirts in black, navy, grey, white (\$25); Caps in grey (\$10); Stubby coolers (\$6) and wines (white, red, bubbly and a port) for approx \$12 as well as a monster raffle with choice of 4 great prizes, including a TV, DVD, camping tables & recliners, collapsible dog crates, etc.

ACCOMMODATION

In Jugiong:

Jugiong has a very large Reserve (more than adequate for our needs) alongside the Murrumbidgee River, suitable for caravans and other camping.

Clean and well-appointed showers and toilets are available for our use, as well as picnic facilities with tables and barbecues.

Water is available from a number of taps at various places around the grounds.

Power is fairly limited as there are only a few power boxes so this facility will be on a first-come-first-serve basis. Should you not be requiring power, we would ask that you camp away from the power facilities when you arrive. It should be understood that there are no defined sites as such – you create your own. The Jugiong Park Trust fees for camping on the Reserve and use of the facilities are:

Unpowered: \$4 per site per day Powered: \$8 per site per day

(These fees will be collected by a committee member – probably me – for the Park Trust)

An exercise and light-training area with river frontage is available at the Reserve. Firearms not to be used.

The other accommodation in Jugiong is a Motel, situated down the road from the Reserve. It has a liquor licence and dining room and the following accommodation:

16 twin rooms (1 double and 1 single bed) plus 2 other rooms (3 single beds)

Dogs permitted - usual conditions.

Cost: \$60 per night OR \$50 per night if booking is more than 5 days.
